

There have been many astronaut-authored books issued over the years on various aspects of the American manned space programme but relatively few on the perspective of the ground controllers. This fascinating book offers a perspective of one of the flight controllers from the Apollo programme. Sy Liebergot states that his was a 'journey of personal growth from uncertain beginnings to maturity...' The case could also be said for the maturing space

programme of which he was a part. The text reveals interesting facts and anecdotes from a 'space career' that has covered over 40 years that includes his role on Apollo 13, working on the Skylab, ASTP, shuttle and Space Station programmes.
