



The Rocket Team

Frederick I. Ordway III and Mitchell R. Sharpe, 324 pages, Apogee Books, Burlington, Ontario, 2003, ISBN 1-894959-00-0, hardcover, \$34.95.

This is a republication, with important extras, of a history first published in 1979. The text tells of the German rocket engineers who developed the V-2 missile and brought advanced rocket engineering to the United States after 1945. Working in the U.S., the team created the giant booster rockets that launched men to the Moon. (The main narrative, however, ends in about 1960.) The new edition includes a DVD with movies of rocket launches from the 1920s to the 1960s, including color footage of V-2 launches. Also on the DVD are two lectures on space flight by rocket team leader Wernher von Braun.
