Sex In Space (CG Publishing Inc, 2006; \$22.95), by Laura Woodmansee

You might tell your boyfriend that his technique takes you into outer space, but did you ever think about actually doing it in zero gravity? Laura Woodmansee, who's written on females in space before, takes the obvious next step and asks, "what about sex in space?" From a scientific point of view, she discusses how space travel changes the libido and how zero gravity might affect pregnancy, but she also gets into the nuts and bolts. How does a guy hang on to his partner when, with each thrust, she's propelled further away from him into infinity? Hand and foot grips, Woodmansee suggests. As for foreplay, try to resist getting turned on by an intergalactic striptease - loosened clothing floats away. If space tourism truly is the wave of the future, then sex is essential. Since there's no reason why an orgasm in space shouldn't happen, Woodmansee suggests a "Cosmic Kama Sutra" might be in order. So, has anyone ever done it up there? No one's sure, but we're willing to bet that there's no way those astronauts kept it in their pants past liftoff. After all, Buzz Aldrin was pretty sexy in his day...
