

The Simple Universe presents the idea that the universe is not just evolving around us, but is also within us. Authors Brewster and Shiwrām seek to enlighten by providing a historical context of humanity’s never-ending quest to understand the “big questions” — our human desire to understand the universe, our place in it, and our relationships with one another. Highlighting what the world was like before and after Galileo’s observations of the skies, this book provides a historical and cultural perspective without attempting to prescribe any answers.
